**Epping Wholesale Market Store Ballot – registrations close this Friday**

The Department of Business and Innovation (DBI) has received a substantial amount of registrations for the ballot for wholesale fruit and vegetable stores at the new Epping market. However, there are still some store leaseholders who have not submitted their ballot registration forms.

We strongly encourage all store leaseholders who have not submitted their ballot registration form to do so immediately.

Registrations for the ballots for fruit and vegetable stores close at 5pm sharp this Friday 30 November 2012.

Please note the ballots for fruit and vegetable stores are for eligible store lease holders only. This ballot is not for stand licence holders, café operators or flower market stand licence holders.

**To secure your spot in the ballots for fruit and vegetable stores for the new Epping market you must:**

- Read the notice from the Minister for Major Projects to all store leaseholders offered space at the new Epping market available on the MMA website.
- Complete the attached ballot registration form.
