COVID-19 CONDITIONS OF ENTRY NOTICE TO THE MMA MARKET SITE



REGARDING COVID-19

The purpose of this notice is to outline changes to the conditions of your entry to the MMA Market Site.

To assist in containing the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and reduce the risk of exposure to Market users, MMA requires you to comply with these modified conditions of entry to the Market.

COMPLIANCE NOTICE

**THIS IS AN IMPORTANT DOCUMENT: YOU MUST READ IT
CAREFULLY**

The MMA conditions of entry to the Market have been altered to reduce the risk of Market staff and users being exposed to COVID-19. These measures reduce the risk to ALL Market staff and users but are also important for the health and wellbeing of the broader community. MMA reserves the right to take any action it considers appropriate against a person who refuses to cooperate and makes a false declaration.

MMA reminds you that it is your obligation to comply with all relevant State and Federal laws and the advice and directions of Government Authorities in response to COVID-19

In line with MMA Pandemic Plan guidance, entry restrictions apply to the following persons:

- Those who have recently travelled internationally or interstate, until they have completed their required self-isolation period.
- Those who have been asked to self-isolate, including those who have attended an exposure site, had close contact with any person suspected of having COVID-19 or been in contact with a confirmed case in the past 7 days (or 14 days for unvaccinated persons).
- Those who are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms (including fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose and nausea). For a full list of symptoms, (see [here](#)).
- Those who have tested positive either by a PCR or a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) in the past 7 days (or 14 days for unvaccinated persons) and are yet to return a negative test.

If you fall into any of these categories, you will be denied access to the Market.

For Contractor and Supplier personnel, you must also inform your manager and MMA representative. If there are any particular requirements or policies which apply to your organisation, you should also comply with those arrangements.

If you believe that there is a particular exception which applies to you, please advise and MMA can take that into consideration but is under no obligation to admit entry to the Market.

Access Card and Vaccine passport presentation on arrival

On your arrival to the Market daily, you may be required to present a valid access card and for inspection evidence confirming that you have received either at least a single dose (on and from 15 October 2021), second vaccination (on and from 26 November 2021), and if you are a "food distribution worker" a booster (the deadline for persons eligible for a third dose on or before Wednesday 12 January is Saturday 12 February 2022. Persons not yet eligible for a third dose will be required to get it by 12 March 2022) against COVID-19 (or have a medical contraindication as defined in the applicable Chief Health Officer's directions) in order to enter the Market. This can be provided by either:

- checking into the Market via the Services Victoria application with evidence of vaccination registered on your Services Victoria account; or
- showing your evidence of vaccination or medical contraindication to a nominated Market staff member for inspection.

If you do not present evidence of vaccination or medical contraindication, or your evidence of vaccination or medical contraindication is deemed insufficient, your business principal will be contacted to ensure the Chief Health Officer's (authorized workers) Direction is compiled with. If you are the business principal in this circumstance, the MMA may notify an authorized officer (as defined under the Direction) to ensure employer responsibilities are met under the Direction.

If you do not present a 'valid' access card (or the access card does not belong to you), the MMA will take possession of that access card and you will NOT be permitted to enter the Market.

MMA will not retain any personal or health information arising from the test.
